Magdeleine is an active resource focused on curated photography browsable by subject, dominant color, and license type. The original list described it this way: “Sort photos based on colors and tags, updated daily.”

Best uses

Magdeleine is most relevant for mood-driven design, color-coordinated layouts, nature, architecture, people, food, objects, and abstract imagery. Search by the subject, orientation, visual style, and required output size rather than choosing an image only because it is free.

Licensing and commercial-use considerations

Magdeleine mixes CC0 images with images that require attribution. The license filter is useful, but the specific image page controls what credit or conditions apply.

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
