Pixabay is an active resource focused on photos, illustrations, vectors, video, music, sound effects, GIFs, and 3D models. The original list described it this way: “(Images after Jan. 09, 2019 must be modified!) Must add additional elements for commercial. Over 320,000 free photos, vectors and art illustrations.”

Best uses

Pixabay is most relevant for general website imagery, multimedia projects, backgrounds, illustrations, and projects that benefit from several media types in one search. Search by the subject, orientation, visual style, and required output size rather than choosing an image only because it is free.

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
