Realistic Shots is most relevant for projects seeking a smaller, less polished archive of natural-looking photographs. Search by the subject, orientation, visual style, and required output size rather than choosing an image only because it is free.

The site remains reachable and links to terms, but its visible collection and copyright footer appear dated. Verify the terms and the individual download before relying on old update-frequency claims.

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
