Current status

Best uses

The Stocks is most relevant for discovering design tools and asset providers across many categories, including but no longer limited to stock photography. Search by the subject, orientation, visual style, and required output size rather than choosing an image only because it is free.

Licensing and commercial-use considerations

The Stocks now acts as a directory rather than an image licensor. Each linked resource has its own terms, so verify permissions at the original destination.

“Royalty-free” does not automatically mean no-cost, public domain, or unrestricted. Copyright permission also does not necessarily clear trademarks, artwork, private property, publicity rights, or a recognizable person’s likeness.

What to check before downloading

- Open the specific asset page and save its current license or receipt with your project records.
- Confirm whether attribution, modification, an extended license, or an account is required.
- Check restrictions on resale, print-on-demand products, templates, logos, redistribution, sensitive topics, and AI training.
- Verify model and property releases when identifiable people, interiors, artwork, or private locations appear.
- Make sure the resolution, crop, file format, and visual style fit the final placement.
